  - a) Treasurer(s)

- I. Booster Account: \$6,376.26
  - Copier
    - An annual contract was signed. We will conduct meter reads every quarter.
  - Trip Account \$1,245.95
- 3) Old Business
  - a) Band Handbook Contracts and Medical Forms
    - I. We are still collecting these forms that were due on Friday, August 17<sup>th</sup>. These will be counted as a zero in the gradebook as a written assignment by the end of the quarter.
      - Four students have not turned them in. Mr. Ostrow is making phone calls.
  - b) Beginning Band
    - I. Retention
      - After MANY schedule changes at the beginning of the year, as of today, we are holding at 74 beginning band students. The schedule changes were for a variety of reasons and not always band related.
      - Mr. Ostrow and the front office agreed that students would not be able to change until after the test drive on August 20<sup>th</sup> and written consent would be required. This procedure was largely ignored for band and a variety of subjects.
      - Mr. Ostrow requested a meeting with administration which was held on Thursday, September 27<sup>th</sup>. We agreed to the following:
        - The drop request forms were creating instability across campus and would no longer be used.
        - It will require parent approval to move a child in or out of any class and will not be simply up to the students.
        - With the exception of the first few weeks of school, students will not be moved into or out of a class until the beginning of the semester or quarter.
        - The Ainger Leadership committee will bring this topic up at the next meeting to be held on Friday, October 12<sup>th</sup>.
          - This meeting was just postponed.
  - c) Sponsors
    - I. Sponsorships to be on the t-shirt ended on Tuesday, September 25<sup>th</sup>. Our sponsors have been posted on <u>www.aingerband.org</u> under the sponsor's page.
    - II. CCPS' Remind texting was used to reach parents as a final push for sponsors.
    - III. Currently at \$2,900.
  - d) Pool Party
    - I. Kids had fun and were well behaved.
    - II. About 60 kids attended.
  - e) All State Auditions
    - I. Both Julia and Nathan were prepared and played beautifully for the mock auditions we held on Wednesday, September 19<sup>th</sup> at LBHS in the band room.
    - II. Both Nathan Soto (clarinet) and Julia Lehman (trumpet) auditioned on Saturday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>. We will not know until sometime in November if they made it into the MS All State Band. Mr. Ostrow will receive an e-mail.

- III. Hotel We should book two rooms with two beds in each at the La Quinta near the Tampa airport. January 9, 10, and 11. Mr. Ostrow will need one and the student and his/her parents will need one.
  - If both students make it, we will book another room.
  - If neither make it, we can cancel the second room.

        - is hauling the trailer and will leave it at LBHS behind the band room.
      - 5pm we depart by bus to LBHS.
      - 5:15-6:45pm The LBHS Band Director organizes the kids and we supervise.
      - 7pm Return to the bus loop and go home.
    - III. Friday performance
      - 5:45pm Chaperones and students meet in the band room at LBHS.
      - Students warm-up with the LBHS Marching Mantas and walk out to the field together.
      - The students will perform the Star Spangled Banner with a presentation of the colors followed by the LBHS Fight Song.
      - For the remainder of the game, students will join the HS band in the stands.
        - Only students and chaperones may be in this zone. Chaperones can bring the kids water and walk them in groups to the restroom as needed.
        - Kids may not leave the stadium from here.
      - Students will be escorted by the chaperones back to the band room after the half time show or after the game. Their parents selected the option.
        - Students that received an instrument from the trailer must put it back in the trailer.
      - After the game, \_\_\_\_\_ is hauling the trailer back to Ainger.

    - I. Packets will be distributed to the students on 10/22. Last accepted by 11/2.
