- Performing Ensembles:
  - Beginning Band (50 students)
    - 7 flutes, 15 clarinets, 13 trumpets, 13 trombones
    - Some Percussion Ensemble students can perform with them for concerts.
    - Intermediate (37 students) and Advanced Band (36 students)
      - 11 flutes, 2 oboes, 18 clarinets, 4 altos, 2 tenors, 1 bari sax, 1 bass clarinet
        - 9 trumpets, 5 horns, 9 trombones, 4 euphoniums, 8 tubas
        - Some Percussion Ensemble students can perform with them for concerts.
  - Jazz Band (27 students)
    - Every part is covered and/or doubled. This ensemble can stand alone.
    - Percussion Ensemble (13 students)
