## Meeting Called to Order at 6:00pm

- 1) Treasurer(s) Report
  - a) Treasurer(s)
    - I. Booster Account: \$8317.38 as of 08/29/2019
      - In addition to our approved purchases from the last meeting, we purchased accessories for students in need.
      - Mrs. Christian reached out to Venwood and inquired about the missing Woody Herman Jazz Award Plaque. \$42.50 owed to Venwood.
    - II. Trip Account \$1293.57
    - b) Internal School Band Account
      - I. \$1,571 for Repair and Maintenance, Account ID 7200.
        - Removed and not able to use.
      - II. \$2,500 for Repair and Maintenance from the Reynolds Arts Grant, Account ID \$29300
        - Removed per Ellen Harvey and not accessible.
        - Mrs. Harvey plans to use the money to help music teachers and students with the FMEA convention.
      - III. \$8,493.60 (*this number is not accurate*) from the Referendum. To be used to purchase new instruments and repair and maintenance. Mr. Ostrow is working to request this account can be used for purchasing instrument lockers to replace the black lockers in the band room.
        - We spent \$5,756.40 on brass summer repairs at Cadence Music.
        - We spent around \$750 for woodwind summer repairs from Larry Mynett.
        - Mr. Ostrow also purchased lyres and flip folders for AB as well as some other needed accessories.
        - This number will be updated at the next meeting after invoices have cleared.

### 2) Old Business

- a) Scheduling for 2019-20
  - I. 3 beginning bands, intermediate band, advanced band, and jazz band.
    - As of 8/1, the front office scheduler reported 65 currently in beginning band, 44 in intermediate, 55 in advanced, and 32 in jazz band.
    - As of 8/29 we currently have 82 (+17) in beginning band, 50 (+6) in intermediate band, 52 in advanced band (-3), and 28 (-4) in jazz band.
      - Our recruitment efforts at open house resulted in gains in most classes.
    - Mr. Ostrow also directly recruited 7<sup>th</sup> graders in period 2 Home Economics, and 6<sup>th</sup> graders in period 6 and 7 art. This was a one for one swap and did not affect any of the core classes. Mr. Ostrow will definitely do this every year.
      - o Mr. Ostrow only recruited students for instruments that were low (trombone,
        - percussion, and trumpet) after the Instrument Test Drive.
- b) Band Parent Pizza Social
  - I. We had lots of parent volunteers on the laptops. The google forms are also posted on the website and we can send a Remind if we are short on volunteers for an event.
    - Andie will work with Mr. Ostrow to find out what he needs for each event, then she will contact the volunteers and tell them what to do.
  - II. Other pizza count 28 were purchased and we could have used more.
- c) Instrument Test Drive and Basic Training
  - I. Most students attended both events. All but two students now have instruments and all of their accessories.
  - II. We have achieved a balanced band with:

- 11 flutes, 21 clarinets, 6 altos, 11 trumpets, 6 horns, 9 trombones, 3 euphoniums, 6 tubas, and 8 percussionists.
- III. Recommendations for next year:
  - Have a refreshments table by the stage and near the Teacher's Lounge
  - Stagger start time or provide clearer expectations on wait time for parents
  - Hire at least two clarinet clinicians and maybe one more closer for the Teacher's Lounge
