# ✓ For parents whose child is using a school owned instrument:

- o All school instruments must be returned to the band room before summer begins.
  - If it is a large instrument, you can drop it off in the office between 8-9:20am. The office is open in the summer!
  - If it is a smaller instrument, please have your child bring it to the band room.
- o For returning Ainger band students that will need an instrument.
  - Instruments will be issued only after a summer instrument usage form has been returned signed and if the instrument is in working order.
    - Mr. Ostrow needs time to assess the condition of the instruments and to maintain/repair them with the local vendors. If your instrument is ready, you will be called at the number on your UAF and you can pick it up in the front office at Ainger. No instruments will be issued without a form.
    - If you lose the form that was provided in class, the usage agreement form can be found under "Forms" on our band website at <a href="https://www.aingerband.org">www.aingerband.org</a>.
- o For students that need instruments in the LBHS Band:
  - Come to the Step Up meeting on Friday, May 25<sup>th</sup> at Ainger in the band room from 4-7pm. A school rental form will be provided for you there with instructions on how to get a summer instrument.

# ✓ Students that are eligible for All-State:

- o Rising 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders will receive information detailing what All-State is and how to acquire the materials to prepare for an audition in September.
- o Students were selected based off of their band placement auditions (scale test).

## ✓ Scheduling for 2017-18 School Year:

- o Students will be placed into the intermediate, advanced, jazz and/or percussion ensemble based on the following criteria:
  - Instrumentation.
  - Auditions, concert and rehearsal attendance, and classroom performance for the 2017-18 school year.
  - Student performance in "Core" classes.
    - A student with double math/reading might not be able to be placed in the ensemble of choice.
- Student Band placement will not be announced until students return for open house in August as there are MANY other factors regarding the school master schedule; however, a recommended placement list will be posted with student ID numbers to the band site.
- o Additionally, every student will have a private consultation with Mr. Ostrow during exams week.
