- 1) Treasurer(s) Report
 - a) As of December 31st, 2021
 - I. General Fund \$5,590.50
 - Donations

 - Payments
 - Lemon Bay Theater Support (Sound and Lights at the Winter Concerts), \$100
 - o Dominos Pizza on 12/7 and 12/16 (IB and Honor Band Rehearsals), \$171.29

 - Candle Sales Recap
 - Issues amount has been reduced to \$70. The Cooke family replaced their \$144

 - Students will be excused from school as a "County Activity" but will be asked to make up any missed work for their classes.
- II. Performance:

 - o Students are being asked to wear formal black and white attire.
- c) Winter Concerts
 - I. It was a good idea to split the concerts into two as the performance length was perfect (just under or just over an hour).
 - JB and BB first week
 - IB and AB the second week
 - II. Although we had to move equipment twice, it was easier to set up as there were only two ensembles at a time.
 - III. The parents who had students perform at both concerts (Jazz Band) did not mind attending two concerts.
- d) Beginning Band Retention
 - 86/94 were retained.
 - II. We are starting 4 tubas, 1 euphonium, 5 horns, and 6 altos.
 - Students are meeting every Monday morning with 8th grade mentors to review fundamentals with Mr. Ostrow.
 - III. Administration is happy with the results and seeks to continue with the new registration.
 - 5th Grade Students will have a "Step Up" Day in March where they will see the band perform and Mr. Ostrow will recruit.
 - Parents will have a Registration Night in late March or early April and will be asked to complete a 1-4th choice on a google form.
- e) Universal Studios
 - I. We had to move our date to Saturday, April 23rd, 2022 with pick up at 7am due to a shortage of local charter buses that are available.
 - Permission from Mr. Harvey has been granted.
 - II. Cost
 - Need submission for tickets by 3/1/22
 - o Fees
 - \$109 for one day, 2 parks.
 - \$32/chart bus parking (currently 4 buses)
 - \$30 in gift cards per student for a "meal plan"
 - The price of a meal with a drink averages \$15-20
 - No meal plans offered any longer; however, we can purchase gift cards.
 - Can be used for other things if not spent.
 - Charter Buses to be paid with Fall Fundraiser.
 - Students to receive discounts for the following:
 - Auditioned for Honor Band, \$20
 - Registered to play a solo at Solo and Ensemble, \$30
 - Two payments due at the beginning and end of February
