

## Band Lock-in Newsletter!

The band lock-in is for BAND STUDENTS ONLY. The purpose of the lock-in is to serve as a fun social event exclusive to band members. We are also hosting a fun-filled “rehearsathon” during the lock-in.

If your child would like to attend, they need to arrive at the bus loop gate between 8-8:30pm **Friday, April 12<sup>th</sup>**. The gate will be open at the latest until 9pm. Parents are REQUIRED to sign their children in at the gate between 8-8:30pm and also fill out a permission release along with emergency contact information. Parents that need to pay may also do so at this time. Half a night costs \$15, includes a dinner, and runs from 8pm to 12:30am. A full night costs \$25 and runs from 8pm to 7am. Students are permitted to bring backpacks. At the gate, students will display the contents of their backpack:

- If a student would like to bring snacks/soda, it will be donated to the band at the gate and delivered by a booster parent to the cafeteria. **We will have plenty of food and drink made available through the boosters.**
- Energy drinks are not permitted.
- Students staying for the full night should bring a sleeping bag and a pillow or a blanket and a pillow.
- Students may not bring video games or movies, but hand held devices are permissible.
  - Please note, the band program and the school are not held liable if an electronic device is lost or damaged at the lock-in.
  - Hand held devices such as phones will be held in the band room for emergency uses only.
- School dress code **does** apply (No pajamas, short shorts, spaghetti straps, etc.). Students that arrive dressed improperly will be sent home at the gate.

**The schedule will go as follows:**

Time	Event
8-8:30pm	Check in at the bus loop gate, place sleeping bags and backpacks on the cafeteria stage, report to the cafeteria for dinner.
8:30-9pm	Review the rules, guidelines, and schedule of events for the night.
9-10pm	• Beginners report for sectionals in various classrooms to work on band music with clinicians.
10-11pm	• Report to the band room to play the band music!
10-11pm	• IB/AB report for sectionals in various classrooms to work on band music with clinicians.
11-12am	• Report to the band room to play the band music!
9-12am	When students aren't in a sectional or rehearsal, they will be in the gym or cafeteria for games, sports, or socializing.
12:30am	Parents that paid for a ½ night pick up their children at the bus loop.
12:30-2am	“Bottoms-Down Volleyball” Tournament in the gym with all band members.
2-4am	Movie and popcorn with a drink in the cafeteria.
4-6am	Lights out in the band room, cafeteria and gym will remain open all night for games/socializing.
6-7am	Students clean the cafeteria, band room, and gym; then they organize their stuff and prepare for pick-up.
7-7:30am	Parents that paid for a full night pick-up their children at the bus loop.

**We need chaperones for this event!** Parents, if you can attend the evening of the lock-in, please attend the lock-in meeting on *Monday, April 8<sup>th</sup> beginning at 6pm in the band room.* At this meeting, we will review the procedures, rules, and duties. We need coverage for 12 volunteers all night or we will be forced to cancel the event. Chaperone options include:
