

Middle School Band Night Rehearsal

This is a rehearsal for our annual night at a football game at LBHS. Students should dress comfortably for the rehearsal, but not inappropriately (school dress-code applies). Sneakers and socks must be worn for outdoor marching. There will be a pizza/social break at LBHS. Students will rehearse in the Ainger band room from 4-5pm. The buses will leave Ainger at 5pm and will return around 7:30pm for parent pick-up.

Students will play the Star Spangled Banner and the LBHS Fight Song for a pregame performance with the LBHS band. The point of the performance is to inspire band students to want to join the high school band as well as support the HS band while enjoying their half-time show.

There will not be a bus for this event so please plan in advance. Students are to be dropped off behind the LBHS auditorium where the band room is located. There will be signs posted on music stands to aid with directions. For safety purposes, Students must fill out the form below and place it in the Advanced Band In-Folder by Monday, October 8th.

As the point of the event is to collaborate and support our high school band (*and football team*), students cannot leave the stadium until after the half-time performance, which will take place around 9pm. After the high school half-time band show, students will be chaperoned back to the band room. Parents, you can meet your children there. Students that wish to stay longer may do so and will be picked up after the game in the band room.

Students will wear blue jeans, sneakers, and their band shirt. Band shirts will be handed out at school on Thursday and Friday before the performance.

Additionally, students will need a lyre and flip folder for their instrument for this performance. Please contact a local music store to prepare. Cadence can deliver these to the school if you order by phone at 1-800-262-BAND.
