## 1) Treasurer(s) Report

- a) As of October 31st, 2021
  - General Account: \$18,817.97

- T-shirts designs with SuperT in Port Charlotte. They sent a proof on 11/2 that was incorrect. It is unlikely these will be finished in time for the Veterans Day Parade on 11/6.
  - Tim said the kids could wear the shirts they received at MSBN in October as a backup.
- Candle Sales Huge Success!
  - \$15.720 Total
    - 50% profit = \$8,910
      - 70% for the Trip Account = \$6,237
      - 30% for the General Account = \$2,673

    - We received late candle orders, about 25 candles. Kathy has left a voice mail for the candle company.
- LBHS Band Director, Mr. Eyrich, has offered to submit a check for \$1000 from the BGWC grant. A check has not been submitted for the difference yet.
  - The LBHS Band Boosters met for their monthly meeting and rejected this proposal.
- II. Trip Account \$1,434.48
  - We have reserved 4 buses from All Around Charters for 4/23/22 at 7AM pickup at LAMS. The approximate cost is \$1425 per bus or \$5,700.
  - 70% of the Candle Fundraiser is for the Trip Account = \$6,237
    - o This amount will be moved from the General Account to the Trip Account.
  - The Englewood Moose Lodge 1933 donated a check in the amount of \$2,000 to Mr. Ostrow on 11/2/2021.
    - The treasurer only received the check tonight and this amount will be reflected at the next monthly meeting.
    - This is for scholarship and incentives to help assist students that might not be able to afford (8<sup>th</sup> grade) as well as for students that participate in special events as an incentive:
      - Students must attend all rehearsals and performances

- 3) New Business
  - a) Veterans Parade, Saturday, November 6th
    - I. For Advanced Band and Percussion Ensemble Members
    - II. Bus transportation will be provided to the parade site Port Charlotte Beach Park, 4500 Harbor Blvd, Port Charlotte, FL 33952.
    - III. The parade will run from the Port Charlotte Beach Park to the Veterans Memorial Park on Edgewater Drive. Parents are encouraged to attend! Parents driving to watch are asked to follow signs for parking.
    - IV. Special Note: This will be a joint performance with the Lemon Bay H.S. Band.

  - Students in advanced band, 3 percussionists, and 7<sup>th</sup> graders in jazz band have been invited to audition for this event.
    - Students that audition will receive \$20 discount towards their trip to Universal Studios.
