When:

Saturday, February 8th between 8am and 5pm.

Students performing Saturday should arrive **at least** 45 minutes prior to their scheduled performance time to allow ample time to warm-up and locate rooms. There will be signs posted throughout the campus directing you to where your specific adjudicator is located. You can also use the map provided by Mr. Ostrow. Report to your judge's room 15 minutes before your performance; cancellations may put you ahead of schedule.

Where:

Manatee High School | Manatee HS is located at 902 33rd St Ct W, Bradenton, FL 34205. Driving north on I-902 33rd St Ct W, 75, according to Google Maps, it will take one hour and 7 minutes to drive from Bradenton, FL 34205 | Ainger. You will need to print a map or use GPS.

Performance Attire:

Students should wear their formal concert attire with the black vest, tie/bowtie, and formal wear on the bottom. Please wear a belt if necessary. Remember, you are representing Ainger Middle School at this event. You need to make sure you are looking the part, and are carrying yourself appropriately.

Performance Checklist:

 - 2) Music (with measures numbered)
 - 3) Extra reeds or valve oil/slide grease
 - 4) Appropriate performance attire
 - 5) \$7-10 Cash for food on site (in the cafeteria)
- *NO cell phones in the judge's room*
- *Your accompanist has the music for your judge*

Piano Accompanists for Soloists:

Please be aware that the piano accompanist will be traveling to and from several different rooms. If he is not at your room when it is time for you to perform, he will be there shortly. Allow someone else to go before you until he/she arrives and inform your judge that you are waiting on your accompanist.
