

School-Owned Instruments Usage Agreement Form

There is a limited number of school owned instruments available for students to rent. For beginning band students, after the consultation takes place, discussion of using a school instrument may be discussed with the director. Returning students that used a school instrument in the past will have first pick at using a school instrument.

Check-out: L.A. Ainger Middle School has an inventory of those instruments that are considered expensive to rent or own. There is also a limited number or supply of standard band instruments. These instruments may be checked out by students enrolled in band classes. All woodwind players are expected to supply their own reeds, mouthpieces, and cleaning materials. All brass players are expected to supply their own mouthpieces and cleaning materials.

Repairs: The care and maintenance of the assigned instrument is the responsibility of the student to whom it is rented. *Normal* wear will be allowed and fixed by the director. Repairs of any damage resulting in accidents or carelessness, or lack of proper upkeep will be at the responsibility of the student and his/her parent(s).

Return: Instruments are to be returned in working condition by the end of the school year as posted on the band calendar, May 20th, 2011.
