

All Ensembles, Spring Concert Check List

In preparation for the concert, we will have a Beginning Band Rehearsal in the cafeteria on Tuesday, April 23rd from 4-5:30pm. Intermediate Band and Jazz Band Members will have a rehearsal in the band room on Friday, April 26th from 4-5:30pm. Advanced Band students will not have a rehearsal as their entire ensemble meets daily.

Our Spring Concert will take place Tuesday, April 30th. Students need to arrive at the Lemon Bay High School Auditorium by 6:30pm and follow the check list below.

- a. Performance Attire
 - i. Beginning band students wear black on the bottom, and their black band shirt on top, tucked in.
 - a. If you lost this, it is \$10 and you need to inform Mr. Ostrow now.
 - ii. Intermediate and advanced band students will wear black on the bottom, and formal white on top, tucked in.
 - iii. Girls- skirts must be knee length or longer. School dress code does apply.
 - iv. All band students must wear black dress shoes/socks!
 1. The boosters have some shoes and socks. See Mr. Ostrow as soon as possible to borrow a pair.
 2. Girls can wear formal open toed dress shoes without socks; however, these must be formal and not flip flops.
 - v. Failure to wear the appropriate attire will result in a student not performing.
- b. Bring
 - i. Your instrument and music.
 1. Percussion instruments will be on the stage.
 - a. Percussionists must bring their own snare sticks. The mallet rack will be provided.
 2. School tubas, euphoniums, and horns will be behind the stage curtain. Students MUST bring their own mouthpieces.
- c. When You Arrive
 - i. Know where to go:
 1. BB students will report to the stage to set up and warm-up with Mr. Ostrow.
 2. IB and AB students will report to the LBHS band room to warm-up with Mr. Eyrich.
 - a. If a student plays multiple instruments, remember to assemble and take both out with you.
 3. JB students may assemble in the LBHS band room and then report to the front of the stage.
- d. After the Concert
 - i. Students and parents must stay for the duration of the concert (roughly 7-8:20pm) to support all ensembles.
 - ii. After the Advanced Band has performed:
 1. BB students will meet their parents in the black box theater.
 2. IB and AB students will meet their parents in the LBHS band room.
 3. JB students will clear the stage with Mr. Ostrow and then pack up and meet their parents in the LBHS band room.
