

Universal Studios and IOA Band Trip, 2022

For All Cougar Band Members



- ✓ **What:**
 - Students in the Ainger band program will have an opportunity to attend Universal Studios and Islands of Adventure with the Band. This is an end of the year celebration trip just for Cougar Band students.
- ✓ **When:**
 - Saturday, April 23rd, All Day (7am-11:30pm)
- ✓ **Where:**
 - Universal Studios, Orlando
- ✓ **Student Contract:**
 - Students need to do the following to attend the trip:
 - Behave from now (January 25th) up to the trip! No referrals in or outside of Band classes.
 - If a referral is issued, individual circumstances will be considered.
 - Attend required rehearsals and performances. See the band calendar here: <https://www.aingerband.org/calendar.html>
 - Make all payments by the last payment due date of Friday, February 25th.
 - Students that do not meet the above requirements, but have made payments, will be issued a partial refund check (50%).
- ✓ **Cost:**
 - ALL Checks must be made out to L.A. Ainger Band Boosters and turned into the "Payments Box" in the Band Building.
 - PLAN A: \$130 Per Student
 - Includes Transportation, Dual Park Entry, and a \$30 Gift Card for Park Meals and Souvenirs
 - \$65, Payment 1 Due on Friday, February 4th
 - \$65, Payment 2 Due on Friday, February 25th
 - PLAN B: \$65 Per Student
 - This option is for annual *ticket holder passes*. Please e-mail aingerband@gmail.com proof by February 25th (screen shot) of your ticket holder pass showing you are eligible through April 23rd.
 - Includes Transportation, and a \$30 Gift Card for Park Meals and Souvenirs
 - \$65, Single Payment Due on Friday, February 25th
 - Payments MUST be turned into the band room with the slips below. This newsletter can also be found on www.aingerband.org under the "For Parents / Universal Trip" tab.
- ✓ **Chaperones:**
 - Potential Chaperones will be selected from volunteer parents that attended the pizza social in August and indicated interest on the trip intent form. Chaperones will be selected by Mr. Ostrow and the booster board. Selection will be made based on the chaperones previous participation assisting the band program. Selected participants will be contacted shortly after our February booster meeting.
 - Chaperones will be asked to bring their ID's to the front office to conduct a background check to attend the trip. This will occur after you have been selected and contacted by the board.
 - All students and chaperones must ride the charter buses or be transported in a county vehicle unless there is a unique circumstance (School related activity like the State Science Fair, etc.).
 - All chaperones will be placed into a lottery for a free ticket. We receive one free ticket for every ten students. This will take place at the February booster meeting. Chaperones that do not win the lottery will be asked to make a one-time payment of \$100 which includes transportation and dual park entry. Chaperones with ticket holder passes owe \$50 and will need to e-mail the boosters their proof of their season ticket holding.
