Ainger MS and LBHS Jazz Showcase and Dinner Jazz Band Performance and Workshop

What: In preparation for our jazz adjudication festival on Thursday, February 8th, we have organized a performance with the LBHS jazz band. The students will perform for their friends and family that have purchased dinner tickets. Following their dinner performance, the jazz bands will move to a separate stage on site and rehearse with professional jazz educators including Dr. Owen Bradley from North Port HS and Mr. Jose Lopez from Port Charlotte HS.

Tickets: Space is limited to 100 seats; therefore, students have been given one or two tickets (with numbers) and an envelope. Tickets are \$8 each and include a full three-course meal. The students have been asked to return the tickets they have not sold, or return payments for the tickets in the envelope by Tuesday, January 16th so that the organizer can prepare the dinners. *Students that did not receive tickets will be given an opportunity to sell the remaining tickets by Friday, January 19th.* Please write checks out to Ainger Band Boosters.

Ticket purchasers need to visit the website listed on the ticket to select dinner options.

When: Monday, January 29th. Students should arrive at 5:50pm for a warm-up on the second stage. There will be signs posted. Diners are asked to enter the main chapel for dinner. The performance begins at 6:30pm with the Ainger jazz band and will be followed by the LBHS jazz band.

Where: West Coast Church is located near Englewood Hospital off Pine Street between East Dearborn Street and South McCall Road. The church is on the west side of Pine Street. The exact address is 240 Pine St, Englewood, FL 34223.

Bring: Your jazz instrument and music or your snare sticks and music. The band boosters will bring all rhythm section equipment, music stands, chairs, and school percussion instruments/mallets.

Attire: Formal black dress pants or black dress skirt, black dress shoes and socks, and a formal white dress shirt or blouse. Dress shirts should be tucked in. Black dress belts are highly recommended. Girls can wear open toed dress shoes; however, these must be formal and not flip-flops. If your child needs shoes, please see Mr. Ostrow as the boosters have some for students to borrow.
